MARKET STALL INFORMATION

Bring your market stall and join us in the festival village at Lions Park as part of the Cooktown Discovery Festival 2023.

Market stalls will be able to trade for three days from 16-18 June 2023.

SET UP TIMES

- Friday 16 June from 12pm
- Parking is limited and you may be required to walk your stock from your car to your site. Please come prepared.

1. Sites will be allocated by the Event Coordinator
2. Sites will be in Lions and Endeavour Parks only
3. Sites will be allocated based on stall requirements such as power and access
4. Limited powered sites available
5. Stalls selling food will require a Food Business Licence
6. No tent pegs or staking devices will be allowed to secure marquees or other structures due to underground irrigation. Stallholders must provide their own weight devices such as sandbags or water weights. Note: the site can be **very windy** and Council will not be providing sandbags
7. There are to be no glass receptacles used in the park
8. No vehicles are permitted on the parks at any time
9. Stall sites are 3m x 3m. No shelter or furniture will be provided
10. Cook Shire Council will not accept any liability for theft or damage to any property
11. Approval certificates and site allocation will be posted/emailed the week prior to the event. Please print your certificate as you are required to display it at your stall
12. Once certificates are issued no refunds will be paid except in extenuating circumstances
13. Current Cook Shire annual market stallholders have first preference and will not be required to pay any additional fees to trade during the Cooktown Discovery Festival
14. Please no balloons to be used in the market stall area
15. No camping will be allowed on site. Please ensure you have booked your accommodation prior to arriving in Cooktown
16. POWER: If you are plugging into the Council power supply, all power leads must be tested and tagged by a licenced electrician

COVID COMPLIANCE

While there are currently no COVID restrictions for events and markets, Cook Shire Council recommend the following:

- Please ensure you have a supply of hand sanitiser at your stall
- Ensure you remain within your stall area and avoid unnecessary interaction with other stall holders
- Do not attend the event if you are feeling unwell or have any symptoms of COVID-19
